

Bar Supervisor

Responsibilities

- **Preparing Drinks:** Efficiently and promptly prepare all ordered drinks to a high standard, responsible for preparing tea & filtered coffee service, and maintaining the water station.
- **Bar Setup:** Set up the bar before events, which includes cleaning surfaces, shelves, and equipment, as well as restocking and organizing supplies, and prepping garnishes.
- **Closing Duties:** Close down the bar at the end of the shift, following company policies and procedures to ensure everything is properly cleaned and stocked to a high standard and the bar is ready for the following service.
- **Payment Handling:** Manage the till behind the bar, including processing cash and card payments, monitoring drink tabs, and ensuring the till balances correctly, reporting any discrepancies to management.
- **Cleanliness:** Maintain the cleanliness and visual appearance of the bar throughout the shift, adhering to hygiene standards and company policies.
- **Stock Management:** Keep the bar continuously stocked from setup to breakdown and throughout service. Practice stock rotation at all times to ensure freshness and prevent waste.
- **Stock Control:** Conduct regular stocktakes and assist in ordering stock at the end of each week to maintain inventory levels in line with stock requirements for upcoming events. Putting away stock orders when they arrive, cross referencing with the order sheet.
- **Team Collaboration:** Collaborate effectively with wait staff and management, fostering a harmonious working environment. Assisting floor staff as needed, especially with drinks service such as topping up wine and water, and taking additional drink orders. Floor training will be provided.
- **Equipment Care:** Handle all bar equipment with care according to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), ensuring its proper maintenance and functionality.

- Experience: A minimum of 1 year's Bartending experience in a busy, high-volume bar, ideally in an event venue, busy bar, or nightclub.
- Ability to provide high-end drinks service, cocktail experience desirable.
- Proficiency in English Language essential.
